#### Reflections after 200 Games (by Dave Cooper)

As I approach 200 Games this weekend I have enjoyed reflecting back on 25years since I first played for C.A.T.S CC as a favour to a terrific mate to save his Under 16 cricket team from folding. Achieving this milestone means a lot to me and I see it not as an opportunity to celebrate my limited personal achievements in cricket but rather celebrate all that makes CATS, CATS.

From the moment I arrived at the club I have been introduced to, and played with, quality people who give so freely to ensure that the important qualities of club continue to prosper and be strengthen.

CATS to me is a place that welcomes and respects the individual, regardless of their walk of life, their income or in fact even their ability to play. This core belief is the foundation stone on which key club figures Wes Pump, Craig McDonald, Rob Clough and John Black built the club, and is key in the way we have developed unity amongst our players as we strive to add premierships to our meagre collection of flags. A frustration of my time here would be the lack of ultimate success considering that we have been generally 'around-the-mark' too many times. Maybe we needed to toughen upa bit and step over the line, but when you look around the clubrooms on a Thursday night and see TDCA legends like Terry Hunter and Doug Timmins and reflect on their approach to cricket, you can easily see that grit, determination and etiquette make for a far more successful approach.

I was thinking of identifying a few highlights to share with everyone this week, especially those new to the club or those old ones with fading memories. Obviously the four premierships are key milestones in the club's history but reflecting back I was drawn to not achievements, but huge losses. Wes Pump was a key figure in the re-establishment of cricket at Traralgon South in 1985, a premiership player in 85/86 and loved by all for his knock-about nature but also his work ethic around the club. Wes loved Callignee and the ground is named after him. Wes was killed in a car accident and a scarring memory I still recall clearly is the following night at training, his funeral that Saturday and playing on the Sunday. I also recall Billy Miller hitting me across the helmet between overs that game for not concentrating while running between the wickets – maybe I was switched off or maybe Billy was just grieving for a lost mate and my 17yo head was an easy target. Billy repaid this swipe 12 months later when we celebrated our premiership in Wes's honour, and he and Norm Fleming took me to the Astrodome for the first time. My time at the club has been further rocked by the loss of two otherplayers and these two couldn't be more contrasting. Eric Fleming [Flembot's Dad, Tom's Uncle] lost a courageous battle to illness, which was surreal for he was one of the cricketers that was always 'up the battle'. I have great memories of young Flembot attending training and being able to recall his Dad's figures and stats, Eric was a driven performer and thrived onsuccess. In his last summer as his health waned he would arrive at each C-Grade to watch, secretly waiting for a vacant spot. When approached to see if he could help out and possibly field, he raced to his car, popped the boot produced his whites and offered to open the batting. I have nothing but admiration for him still when I tell you honestly he strapped a thigh guard to his chest for protection to a frail body that had shed I'm guessing 75% of its bulk due to his illness. An amazing effort. Havingthe chance to play with Dale and Tom is a real privilege I have, for I know that Eric would have loved the chance to.

Brett 'Froggy' Carroll is represented each year by his family at our Presentation Night, and I would love to take the opportunity with this reflection to re-emphasize what a great honour this award is, but also the courage his family, especially Jim and Irene, and brother AJ have in facing his loss daily. When they attend this season's presentation take the timeto meet them and thank them. Froggy was a care-free cricketer who thrived in the club environment, especially off the field. His untimely death in a work-place accident shook club members, as never in our wildest dreams would you think a good mate could be lost in this way – those types of things were restricted to over dramatic WorkCover adverts. The AXE Awardis made out of Brett's cricket bat and the indents up its edge were caused by him losing his temper going out and bashing it against the ramp railing at the Cattery for good measure. Froggy was a feature of long Saturday nights spent at the Cattery with a fire in a drum out the front and dim sims cooking on the BBQ long into the night. Cricket is a team sport and, as written earlier, premierships are the key measuring stick so identifying individual efforts is not really something I would like to focus on, but I would like to point out a few highlights thatyou might like to recall, or if you're a 'new' player, find out about.

The St. Valentine's Day Massacre – The 1/521 vs Traralgon West at the Pump. The West haven't recovered since, and either has 9ers forgiven Veitchy for snatching the club record from him. Funnier still is Lucky's duck and the fact Nick Turnbull had the pads on for 44.3 overs and missed out on a hit. Still chuffed the Herald-Sun ran my story about it.

Brad Foster's contributions to the 93/94 flag in between wedding duties. Bowled then left, arrived back in a tux, made a very quick 36, left for photos and arrived at the reception not knowing whether or not he was a premiership player. Brad surprisingly has played in 3 of the club's 4 flags.

In only my second game as captain I politely asked Rex Mealand where he wanted his field, he shrugged and said he didn't really think about fielders when he bowled he gave me a hug and said he only worried about knocking the [expletive] stumps over. Well the first ball missed the pitch but the next four balls were wickets. Rex featured in the Express that week photographed with four cricket balls in his hand. Rex was big boy who could have easily given most WWE stars a scare, but was a soft-hearted bloke and great to have on your side.

Dunks also took a hat-trick and I did the Boonie and took the third catch at bat-pad. The most surprising thing was the celebratory huddle In the middle of it was bloody Rex. He was living out of the area, but that day was visiting friends playing tennis and he saw the whole thing happen, jumped the fence and was loving being part of it.

Richo's maiden ton, which set up a win against a red-hot Churchill, was a cracker match that had everything, mainly great knocks and big hits. Morro was hitting boundaries like he was squatting squash balls and Billy Miller played a great supporting role. That year we had an average A-Grade line-up though only missed finals due to an abandoned, restarted final round against wooden-spooners Rovers. What caused that?? Hmmm, how long is a cricket pitch again? Starting the match needing a win to make the four we had Rovers on toast with a flurry of early wickets, only to have the game paused and restarted due to an overly long pitch. The poor curator had painted the lines from measuring crease to crease, instead of stump to stump. Game was lost and another episode of CATS close-but-not-closeenough was written.

Unlikely to make a ton myself unless they bring in four-day cricket to the TDCA, I thrive on being part of batting partnerships celebrating 50/100 runs, and season/club records. I would like to see as all tune in a little more to these milestones as they are a key plank of winning games, especially those first and last few wickets. My favourite partnership I remember is the still current B-Grade opening stand of 166\* scored alongside Billy Miller against a very strong Centrals. Chasing their total in a one-dayer we passed them without loss with a few overs to go. Most of our B-Grade partnership records were scored in two-day games so the current one-day format will protect most of these records. I'm pretty chuffed to have that score sitting there for the last 15 seasons or so. Batting with blokes in partnerships when they score tons is great too. Last year was terrific when Veitchy made is 128 and I made 29 in the same time, though reflecting back maybe Gormandale were deliberately giving me that 6th ball single, denying Veitchy and another double ton! Pumpy's ton at Callignee while a Hilly-Billy Engagement party was in full swing (band, booze and hooch) all cheering and egging him into even more slogs was a great day to be up at the 'Pump'. Other highlights up there would be the day a car appeared from nowhere on a quiet calm day, travelling downhill at speed, lost control and slammed into a power pole beside the oval – and the odd game where Pumpy's old Blue Heeler called Major would awake from his slumber run out to the oval stop the boundary and tear off with the ball.

Playing with my sons has and continues to be a highlight, filling in for C-Grade after Black Saturday and batting with Alexander when he hit the winning runs is a terrific memory while I hope to enjoy the next few years with Harry and who knows what that can deliver. I dream of another CATS flag playing alongside him.

The best cricketers I have played with and against? Probably Rob Clough, Col Scammell, Brad Foster, Paul Veitch, Andrew McMahon, Shane & Shaun Barbour, Brett Knowles, Marc Fenech, Rod Bird, Ash Bolton, Darryl Webber and Chris Membrey. Some just full of class, others impressed their determination and fearless approach to the game and others because they simply got the job done and made it difficult for us.

So without trying to offend, but also to stir up a bit of debate amongst the old timers, I've come up with my Best XIs. I've ended up with two teams, a First XI and a Callignee XI as the Pump deserves its own special place in history. Only provision is that I had to have played with them, so some guns missed out like Kris Wells, Laurie Marks and Andrew McMahon.

**1. CRAIG MCDONALD** – Competitor who did and does take the game seriously. Good technique and approach to open the innings, and super tidy behind the stumps. Courageous keeping up to stumps to faster bowlers to put pressureon batsmen.

2. ERIC FLEMING – Hated losing and going out. Great All-Rounder to have opening both batting and bowling. Softened with age.

**3. ROB CLOUGH** – A class above all others. Arrived in Traralgon as a young pathologist and went from District Firsts to our B-Grade. Dropped to the C's after a first game duck, came back to dominate for years. Set up the first flag in 85/86 making 208\* out of the 9/265 to win the match. Backbone of the club.

**4. PAUL VEITCH** – A quietly mannered heavy-metal junkie who once hosted the club's best mullet. Had some massive scores over the years and put some big hits into the kindergarten at the Cattery.

**5. THEO THEISSLING** – Reverse sweeping since Warner was in nappies! Great left-arm bowler, but terrific bat to round out the package.

**6. BRAD FOSTER** – Veteran who worked his way from C-Grade through to TDCA A-Grade bowling awards.

**7. BILLY MILLER** – Played across all three grades. Reliable in all three aspects of the game. Had a moustache when it wasn't cool!

**8.** JOHN BLACK – Before he perfected Wild Duck Risotto, Bono could play the game. By the time I played with him he was limited to big hits, slow running between the wickets and cheeky bowling [at times he even waited for the batsman to take guard!]. Still feel guilty for running him out cold one afternoon at KLP.

**9. PETER MORRIS** – Classy bowler who had more catches dropped from him than anyone in the game. Funny man.

**10. ANDREW ENGLAND** – wouldn't be happy batting behind Morro. What a work-horse, Great clubman who always encouraged and praised his team-mates.

**11. COL SCAMMELL** – Amazing bowler, master tactician of the game. Tore hamstring from bone sprinting for third run to avoid facing the Brett/Brad Knowles combo.

**1.** WES PUMP – Champion little nugget who laughed his way through a game, set a high standard in way he treated his team-mates. The Mayor of Pumpsville.
