John 'Bono' Black 28/08/1954 - 13/11/2021

Callignee & Traralgon South Cricket Club sadly acknowledges the passing of Life Member John Black. Bono passed away after a long illness and our members, past and present, are mourning the loss of such a wonderful man, a significant contributor on and off the field for decades and a central figure in developing the ethos of our club. After playing cricket out South as a youngster John returned to represent and lead the re-born CATS cricket club in the late 1980's after a distinguished career at Glengarry CC. Bono played 142 games across all grades, sadly without a premiership but playing in two losing grand finals teams across his CATS career. Blacky's farmyard misadventures restricting him from reaching further milestones. In trying to compare him to a current player you could align him to Marcus Stonis - a rugged brute who could impact a game with both bat and bowl. But in regards to the Stonis good-looks and charm? Probably let down by the haircut.

More significantly though was Bono's active off field roles primarily as President but also in a number of other roles, some well-known but plenty done quietly. As the club canteen offerings grew beyond VB cans, Coke and Salt & Vinegar chips, Blacky (with sidekick youngest daughter Joey) became the kitchen staff on Thursday nights and over the years the hotdogs and dim sims were replaced by Wild Duck Risotto, Greek Mousaka and Curried Sausages. Bono's Thursday night meals attracted a strong following of TDCA legends and good mates, while the cricketers only hoped that the old-timers hadn't consumed all of Bono's offerings before they had gotten off the training track.

Bono was in his element holding court at the cricket club, and loved the banter between teammates young and old - we will all hold memories of him chuckling like a little kid as he stirred us or shared another joke picked up during his week sourced anywhere from the saleyards, the carpark at Safeway or the back storeroom at Manny's Market. Blacky showed no favouritism and warmly welcomed the star player through to the most awkward junior. He was universally loved by

took us all under his wing and was essentially a second dad to generations of CATS cricketers, thrilled with our onfield performances but prouder of our personal milestones like marriages, the birth of our kids or career achievements. Likewise he offered wise counsel when our lives hit unexpected bumps and gave strong leadership when the club experienced dark moments. As a mentor, John Black's legacy is simply immeasurable.

In recognition of Bono's contribution to the Traralgon South community (remembering that beyond his cricket club affiliation he was also the Shire President in the pre-Latrobe City local council mergers as well as a selfless worker in the aftermath of Black Saturday) the Traralgon South ground was rebranded the John Black Oval. In an honour usually reserved for those people who have passed away, Blacky had the joy of having the Reserve being named after him.

Already the club's Best Clubperson annual award is aptly named in John's honour while the anticipated traditions we will enact in the following weeks simply will not be able to express the grief we have experiencing as a club and as individuals.

As Bono's health deteriorated over the past few years he continued to keep an eye on us from a distance, chasing updates of the team performances and occasionally being in the car park to soak up the chaotic excitement of junior training nights at the Cattery. As we celebrated our most recent Premiership Reunion, he made the effort to attend the night and was probably embarrassed in the way he was embraced as a demi-god, but we were so thrilled to share the night with him amongst us. In what was seen as a quiet omen, Bono shared his best wishes with us on Grand Final morning as the senior squad gathered for a pre-match breakfast prior to the delivery of a much awaited premiership this year. Bono was happy to be a part of the build-up as car horns and double parked cars created a hindrance in Hotham Street as we shared our game-day excitement with a club legend.

Over the years the cricket club has lost too many from its ranks and we sadly are assembling quite a heavenly squad. Hopefully Bono's arrival at the Pearly Gates will bring an end to some of the angelic shenanigans but probably he will sit back with his old lab Chloe slumped loyally at his feet and simply

enjoy the company of good friends.

Bono - we are simply heartbroken you have left us.

Mandie, Jess, Maddie, Joey and your large family connections - we offer our deepest condolences at the loss of someone who was so deeply loved, knowing Bono delivered such joy to his extended family.

Rest in peace Bono, we will miss you.

Local cricketers are prone to exaggerate, especially prior to the fact-checking capacity of MyCricket, but to declare Saturday 26th March as the best day in the history of CATS Cricket Club is certainly no wild exaggeration.

Prior to the finale of Season 2021/22 the silverware shelf behind the Rudi Bence Bar at the Cattery wasn't too cluttered. Senior flags were 85/86 (B), 93/94 (C), 07/08 (A) and 20/21 (A) while the recent strong performances across our junior program provided most of the cups adorned with their fresh red and blue ribbons. Heading into the weekend we again had the A's and C's in action like last year. The A's were promoted up into the Premier A-Grade division after the 21/22 premiership and rocketed into consecutive grand finals after a blistering final month. The C's were the benchmark team across the home & away season and went into the final series in the dangerous position of being favourites.

By Saturday evening when Club Coach Davin Charleston had risen to his feet to address a Cattery full of red and blue, the senior premiership tally had grown to six. Ben Julin, now our dual-premiership Captain, influential with key wickets in A-Grade's second flag in twelve months, stood before an excited crowd alongside loyal club servant Dale Fleming. Acknowledging the need for our club to raise our expectations of each other has seen Davin, Ben and Dale produce three of our club's six senior flags since the club's reestablishment in 1985/86.

Alongside the on-field leaders, our club executive led by President Vaughan Penrose also needs to be acknowledged for their outstanding efforts and generous volunteerism that has seen our club not only survive but thrive during the pandemic interrupted seasons of the past few years.

A-GRADE MATCH REVIEW

For a long time, dreams of an A-Grade Flag were just that, dreams. Even the success of last year had that quiet mummering around it being in the lower division. But with this season's back-to-back wins we not only celebrate our sixth club flag we also recognise the opportunities that come along with the multi-tiered model on offer in the LVDCL. The A's fought back from regulation with two premierships while in C-Grade the boys were triumphant against Willow Grove, aspirant future participants in higher grades if they can harness the talent pouring through their excellent junior program.

The cut throat nature of the A-Grade competition saw the post-Christmas surge to finals filled with do or die battles across the league. After a poor start to the year the A-Grade squad tightened the screws to stampede into the finals and took all before them. Morwell fell at the last hurdle in the semi to lose 3/1 with a last over run out handing a Grand final berth to the boys from the Cattery against Churchill, who had finished the home and away season seven games clear of CATS on the ladder. An interesting insight was that during the season CATS, the newly crowned Premier A Champions, had been defeated by Jeeralang-Boolara who would end up as wooden spooners in the lower A-Grade division. An indication of the competitiveness of the league and food for thought as the structure of the association is analysed post-season.

Played at Ted Summerton Oval in Moe, the Premier A-Grade Grand Final enjoyed both outstanding on and off field facilities. Electing to bat after winning the toss, Ben Julin was confident in the capacity of his squad to bat deep and set a defendable total against a Churchill side containing some tremendously strong strikers of the ball. The CATS batting line up this year contained six players with 200+ run seasons so the scene was set to see which players would step up as the match winners.

Opening with Panyangara and league batting-average champion Cochrane, CATS were optimistic as much as Churchill were in an early wicket. Our free-flowing, aggressive batting habits are our greatest asset while the key bowlers from Churchill had proven all season that they had the capacity to restrict runs. Tinashe (4) looked threatening but fell early, and then what followed was a series of missed opportunities for the Cobras as they dropped catches, and had run outs and appeals turned down.

The Cochrane/Harrup partnership grew through a mix of classy stroke play and aggressive running between the wicket, which due the admiration of the commentary team members. With the scoreboard ticking over steadily, the talk via the Red-Onion match coverage was that a score approaching 280 was likely. However, the CATS boys kept focussed on the team approach that had seen them consistently value smart strokeplay and aggressive running over crowd-pleasing slogging. When Cochrane (69) was dismissed with the score on 2/122 the partnership had grown to 109, the highest second wicket stand in A-Grade across the season. To have this quality partnership in a Grand Final was so important and showed the capacity of our top order who actually had all first four wicket partnerships of the season achieved against the powerhouse teams in Morwell and Churchill.

Skipper Julin (12) joined young Harrup at the crease, while at the same time Harrup Senior was setting up C-Grade with a similar innings against Willow Grove out at Yinnar. Sadly Tony's 22 runs couldn't be added to Nathan's 80 runs as the youngster thoroughly deserved a prized premiership century. While the rest of the batsmen all had short stays at the crease they all played a role in moving our total beyond our semi-final tally. Finishing on 225 we were content although potentially in hindsight could have pushed a total closer to 250.

Losing eight wickets, two off the last balls of the innings, the scorecard had J.Keyhoe (9), Stewart (20 off 17), D Keyhoe (8) and Hare (8 off 6) as the other contributors on the day.

Taking to the field with a squad full of players capable of bowling, Julin was prepared to switch and manipulate his bowlers around. With some obvious experienced bowling talent in the team it was still not easy to predict where or how the wickets would fall. The team-first approach of supporting the bowling with strong fielding efforts was a club-wide focus. Stewart was sensational in his opening spell bowling into an unfriendly breeze allowing Panyangara to attempt the breakthrough, snaring both openers with Richie Benaud cheering on with the score on 2/22. Deliberate bowling changes saw short spells, with veteran Hare popping in to grab the third wicket (3/24) after Stewart took a beautiful reflex catch in short-cover.

Tinashe bowled viciously at Warr with the YouTube replaying showing him uncomfortably bobbing around the crease before being set up scooping an easy catch to batting hero Harrup handing our favourite Zimbabwean his third for the day (Churchill 4/25). Julin with the ball turned the match, snaring the key wicket of Mason (a sensational sharp catch in first slip by Hoch) with the score on 5/32 just as the supporters in Yinnar were cheering on the C-Grade win. BJ (4/23 off 9) must have somehow been inspired by the early finish by the boys out at the Ranch as he proceeded to take the next three wickets himself after some excellent support in the field. With the game well and truly taken away from Churchill, Tinashe (5/17 off 6.5) re-entered the scene and took 2/0 in his final over of the day to deliver a consecutive flag to his beloved CATS Cricket Club.

Panyangara was awarded the Man of the Match medal making up for the disappointment of the previous GF loss to Churchill and after being overshadowed by a rampaging Stewart last year. Tinashe's five wicket haul catching the eye of the umpires in deciding the MoM medal or was it for the fact he actually had not made a third-consecutive Grand Final duck?

Congratulations to Skipper Ben Julin, Club Coach Davin Charleston, the premiership players and the large squad of players who rolled through A-Grade this year. Premierships are great moments but to have executed a game plan so brilliantly across the semi and grand final matches says plenty about the capacity of these premiership leaders and players.

C-GRADE MATCH REVIEW

The monkey is off the back and we have welcomed in a new batch of C-Grade Premiership players at CATS. After years of so-close-so-far, Flembot and the boys delivered the goods on a beautiful sunny day out at the Yinnar Ranch. Our match day hosts, Raiders, have a long history of premiership success so to have the day like we had on Saturday serves as motivation to repeat this again and again.

After the disappointment on the same ground last year we went into our second GF in two years less anxious and determined to play a strong team-first game. With minimal changes to the squad over the past few important weeks, we only had the one change from the semi with Muzz stepping out of the team as planned to attend a family wedding. Muzz has had a huge year with the bat and was essentially irreplaceable because of his unique capacity to balance power-hitting with outstanding game-awareness. Welcoming fifteen year old Ben Hagley as his replacement into the team joining his father Tom provided yet another father-son combination that our club is so proud of. Ben's selection proved to not only be heartwarming but also matchwinning. An interesting fact about this team was that every player had either a father, son or brother also play at the club this year.

Winning the toss, Dale elected to bat and get the runs on the board - although he was probably looking for about double what we gave him. Batting on the beautifully curated Yinnar Football Reserve we soon had an appreciation that runs were going to be hard to accumulate quickly and using all our allocated overs a priority. Boundaries were difficult and although Dale belted a four and six quickly he soon fell LBW to young Willow Grove star Cumiskey who would go on to record the fine figures of 3/19 off 8. The ex-1990/91 Under 16 pairing of veterans Payne and Cooper took on the opening bowling assault of Dawson/Cumiskey and dragged the score into the 30s before they too joined Fleming in the shed. Hagley Snr and Harrup Snr joined forces to take on the first change combination of bowlers with Tom unfortunately run out, breaking the dismissal mode after the first three wickets of the day had been LBWs. Those following the two CATS Grand Final scores online would have noticed the symmetry as Tony and Nathan Harrup went about setting up each of their teams with innings that mixed concentration with aggression.

Tony was bowled for 22, leaving CATS 5/60 but the deep batting depth of the C-Grade team allowed a flow of players to contribute, dragging out a score of 9/111 at the compulsory closure. Luke Wilson hit a measured 17 followed by McDonald Jnr (2) and Hagley Jnr for a duck. The growing maturity of Ben Hagley evident when in the past such a disappointment would have ruined his day, instead in this instance he shrugged off the negativity and winked knowing he still had a chance to contribute with ball in hand. The difference on the day could also be linked to the batting performance of our number nine, ten and eleven. Old McDonald went E-I-E-I-O batting superbly for 14 on a day where runs were a premium, Bruce Husson's wisdom and class producing 10 no and along the way mentoring young Stonis 5*. Batting out our overs was a significant milestone.

Drinks were taken, confidence was high and the CATS boys were quick to be back out on the ground to get started on what would become the greatest ever CATS C-Grade bowling & fielding performance.

Willow Grove Cricket Club became our foes in the creation of the LVDCL but we have quickly drawn up a strong, competitive relationship. Apart from sharing similar high-altitude climatic conditions, we are both blessed with a strong junior based and community connection. A sign of the strength of Willow Grove was on display when their team was skippered by their Under 16 captain in Kyan Mulley. Kyan not only had an outstanding year statistically but when faced with the disappointment of having to give the losing captain's speech he was gracious and insightful. What an asset he is to his club - We wish him and Willow Grove all the best for the future as all these youngsters push into higher grades.

..... but back to the cricket!

With the opposition having 240 balls to make 112 runs we knew our pre-match tactical work around dotballs and maidens would be critical. Our opening bowlers Wilson Snr and Hagley Snr gave us a dream disciplined start when the opposition top order bats simply couldn't get the ball through the field. The conditions saw the ball hooping around and when the two opening bowlers had exhausted their allocation of overs the score sat on 1/22 off 16. Luke finished with 0/8 and Tom 1/13 - with 7 maidens between them. Ironically Tom's extraordinary figures 1/13 off 8 overs, typical of his regular performances, were actually our worst bowling figures of the match - selectors likely to wield the axe come round 1 next season. Bowling out his two opening bowlers, Skipper Fleming was left to decide his next action - and it proved a masterstroke. Turning to the left-arm orthodox spin of Matt Payne saw the 17th over become yet another maiden. The C-Grade veterans huddled to offer insights for the decision around the 18th over, with the ball thrown to young Hagley to replace his father. Ben started well with each delivery being full and straight until a good length sixth delivery was belted to Payne who took a very sharp catch at mid-off. The catch gave us our second wicket and left Willow Grove 2/23 requiring 89 off 22 overs - the run rate climbing and our small total starting to look like the 200+ total we were hoping for.

The buzz that was starting to seep out of the CATS boys after Ben's wicket turned to out-of-control madness when the very next ball of the game saw the Payne/Hagley combination reverse roles as the Willow Grove opener smacked the ball straight to mid wicket. Players streamed from everywhere to embrace and the what-if dream of a premiership actually took root, we were never going to lose as the momentum all swung into the hands of the boys from the Pump. We had taken 2/0, Willow Grove 3/23. The heart rate of the veterans had not even settled before Tony Harrup took a catch three balls later to have Willow Grove 4/23 - the last five deliveries yielding 3/0.

With the bowlers all following through with the club-wide directives, runs dried up for the batsmen as they tried to wrestle back control. Two more maidens passed before the batsman got hold of a Payne delivery, smashing it straight and flat down the ground. Running (or flying) from mid-on, Cam McDonald managed to not only hold the catch of the year this time, but also managed to regain his feet and remain surprisingly injury-free, not adding to the collection of snapped fingers for the season, only to be mobbed by his teammates including the newly arrived James Guy who had just come on as designated bowler. In those almost eight overs since the bowling change we had taken 4/1 (WG 5/23) and the monkey jumped off Dale's back and was last seen singing 'Freed from Desire' running southwards on Monash Way. Then the *Biggest Day in the Club's History* started to ramp up as the Payne and Hagley Jnr show continued to take wickets at the same time as the growing CATS crowd started to find its voice. At the same time MyCricket updates also started filtering in announcing early Churchill wickets to the A-Grade boys.

6/29 - Another catch to Cam, wicket to Hagley Jnr Mrs.Hagley getting excited.
7/31 - Caught and Bowled Payne...... Mrs.Payne going off!!
8/33 - LBW Hagley Coops crying
9/34 - Caught Hagley, Bowled Hagley It's about to happen

Payne 4/8 from 8 overs, Hagley Jnr 4/9 from 8 overs.

Luke, Tom, Matty and Ben combined to bowl 14 maidens from the first 32 overs. So with one wicket left to take the captain turned to fourteen year old Evan Pass to turn club history on its head to deliver the fifth flag to the Cattery.

Young Stonis sensing the moment stood at the top of his mark, gave the trademark blonde mop of hair a flick to the side and steamed in to take 1/0 after Luke Wilson swallowed a catch at mid-on.

Celebrations erupted on and off field as the enormity of the moment set in. Players, ex-players, families and supporters all overcome with emotion at what had been achieved.

The win represented much more than 12 blokes winning a game of cricket.

It was a win for our club, our community. It was a win for everything that CATS stands for.
